Viewing student information on Qsis

- 1. Go to Qsis (https://qsis.qub.ac.uk) and login using your QoL username/password.
- 2. Under Main Menu click Self Service



3. Click on Advisor Center → My Advisees



4. This will list any active students that are attached to you in Qsis in any capacity e.g. Advisee, Personal Tutee, PhD Students etc.


5. To access a student's Academic Record (which is a transcipt with more information than what is printed on the official/unofficial transcript) select "View Academic Record". A separate window will open with a PDF file (please ensure that pop-ups are permitted in your browser).



6. To access personal student information click on View Student Details



7. From **Student Centre** you can view classes, addresses, phone numbers, emails, emergency contacts and view transcripts and Academic Records.



Viewing Data for other Students

Under GDPR it is no longer possible to view data for students who are not directly attached to your account or your advisees who have been 'Completed' (graduated) in Qsis.

However, if you are writing a reference for a completed student **who you have previously taught** then you can still find their transcript through any class they have attended **in a previous term.**


1. To view class lists from a previous term, click on the **Faculty Center** tab from the Advisor Center or from the **Main Menu**, select **Self Service** → **Faculty Center**.



2. This will, by default, show the current term or the last term you viewed. Click the green **Change Term** button.




3. You will see a list of academic years. This will vary in length depending on how many years you have been attached to classes in Qsis. **Select the appropriate year** and click **Continue**.



4. To access a class roster (class list) click on the class roster icon





5. The class list will display. You can click on the Academic Record link to view the appropriate Academic Record, including for any completed students.
