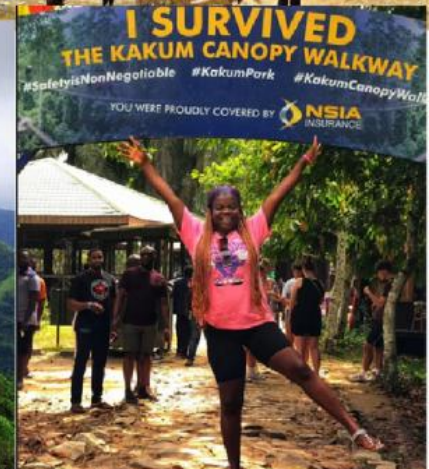
Arrival in Ghana – Friday 30 May
