### Keith Jeffery Memorial MA Scholarship

The Keith Jeffery Memorial MA Scholarship is for a student from a Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic (“BAME”) background. The award will be made in honour of our late colleague Professor Keith Jeffery who published outstanding work on the history of imperialism among other areas. This award will address the current under-representation of BAME students within the School of History, Anthropology, Philosophy and Politics at Queen’s University Belfast by encouraging BAME students to apply for either MA History or MA Public History.

#### **Application**

Applications for the scholarship will be reviewed by a Selection Panel that will take into consideration:

- The quality and feasibility of the applicant's 1,000-word MA dissertation proposal;
- The compatibility between the applicant's proposal and a potential Queen's History supervisor;
- The academic background of the applicant (performance in undergraduate degree).

The proposed project will be on some aspect of imperialism, post-imperialism, race or slavery in any of the geographical areas or historical periods in which Queen's historians work.

The scholarship will cover PGT fees for one year at NI or UK student level only (international students can apply but should be aware that they must have a further source of funds to make up the shortfall between NI/UK fees and international PGT student fees).

We hope to be in a position to notify the successful candidate by late July, alongside any reserve / unsuccessful candidates.
